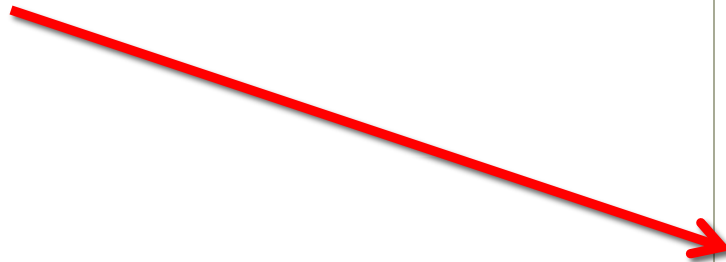

#### **ACC 120 Principles of Financial Accounting**

This course introduces business decision-making using accounting information systems. Emphasis is placed on analyzing, summarizing, reporting, and interpreting financial information.
